The theme of the inaugural 2018 Big Hair Ball is “Carnival Chaos” – think Rio de Janeiro, Brazil Carnival. During the Ball, Runway Models will show off the costumes, hair and make-up that are being designed by Quentin Sagers to represent various Sponsors - all in sync with the Carnival Chaos theme. There will be dinner, entertainment, auctions and fun all evening.

The show will be **Friday, March 23, 2018, at the Greater Jaycees Hall in Waldorf, MD from 5pm till 10pm. Prior to the show it will be necessary to meet with the models up to 4 times.** Depending upon the design and your desire, you may also be asked to attend the show.

VOTING: Big Hair Ball party goers will vote for the costume they like best. The costume with the most votes at the end of the evening will win the “**Most Creative Costume Designer**”.

DETAILS/RULES: All Sponsors are expected to be identified by the end of Dec 2017. Design concepts will be completed as quickly as possible as they are identified. When a Sponsor has been identified, a model selected and a design completed, you will be asked to begin your work. Your skills, desires and time will be considered and coordinated. We expect your start time to be anywhere from now to Jan 2018. All Costumes must be complete by 2 March 2018.

MONEY: All material will be purchased for your use. Labor and your time is what we are asking you to provide.

RECOGNITION: Your name/company will be listed in our program and announced when the model walks the runway. And of course, you will have bragging rights for **Most Creative Costume Designer** if you win.
